As we head into the Thanksgiving and Christmas season this year, there is no doubt that for many of us, our gratefulness to God will be especially abundant as we reflect on His faithfulness through the many months of uncertainty and turmoil that have swept across our nation.

The awesome truth is that as followers of Jesus, our hope isn't determined by the crises and events swirling around us, or even by changing circumstances in our own lives. Our hope, peace, and victory are firmly anchored in the finished work of Christ and in the promises God gives us in His Word.

As Christians, during this holiday season we have an opportunity to demonstrate the

true meaning of gratefulness to God—for His kindness and blessing to us in every situation—and to actively embrace the apostle Paul's encouragement in 1 Thessalonians 5:18: "In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you."

In looking back on America's first Thanksgiving celebration at Plymouth Rock, we discover that our Pilgrim ancestors took time to express their gratefulness to God in spite of some very challenging circumstances they had to face. The Pilgrims' very first Thanksgiving in 1621 occurred following a devastating New England winter during which nearly half of those who landed at Plymouth Rock the previous fall perished from disease, starva-



tion, and the harsh elements. It was only the providential arrival of some local, friendly Native Americans that allowed the Pilgrims to become established, plant a successful crop, and gather at the end of the season to thank God for His faithfulness and provision.

Fast forward four hundred years, and while our circumstances may look far different from that which the Pilgrims faced, as a nation and people we still stand in need of a touch from God. From the ongoing pandemic to the social turmoil

that has impacted so many areas, it is clear that America today needs God's mercy and intervention.

Similarly, like the Pilgrims of old, it is important for us to express our gratitude to God for His faithfulness in our lives and circumstances, in spite of every hardship and uncertainty we may be facing.

Recently, Laurie and I sat down with our good friend, Franklin Graham, to talk about the day of prayer he and other Christian leaders hosted September 26 on the National Mall in Washington, DC. On that day tens of thousands of Christians flooded the area around our nation's Capitol, standing in uni-

Hope and Grace for Poland



In a land once ruled by communist oppression, the light of God's love is breaking through. On the air since 2016, Christian television network TBN Polska is covering the nation of Poland with life-changing programming for every family member.

While the Catholic Church has played a major role in Poland's national identity for centuries, nearly fifty years of efforts by a communist-ruled government to destroy the Christian faith left Poland a spiritually broken nation. In fact, in the country of nearly 38 million people, there are only around 50,000 born-again, evangelical Christians.

But TBN Polska director Krzysztof Rompa recalled that many years ago a core of evangelical Christians prayed for a move of God in Poland, "and some people began to produce Christian programming for the

state channel. Then in the mid-1990s Christians in Poland discovered TBN and began to watch the channel as they were able. Out of that experience was born the vision for TBN Polska."

What started as a three-hour block of programming airing weekly on TBN Europe has grown into a 24-hour network airing a combination of international ministry content, along with Polish-language programs produced in-country.

Today TBN Polska is available in millions of homes via cable, satellite, and over-the-air broadcast. "Millions of Poles are searching for something that will make a difference in their lives," said Rompa, "and we believe they will find it through the programming being aired on TBN Polska. Many already have."

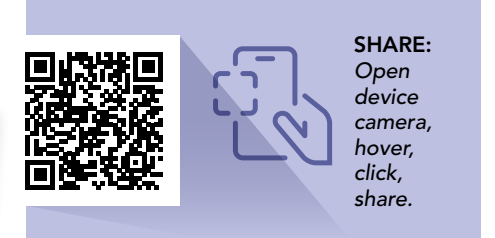

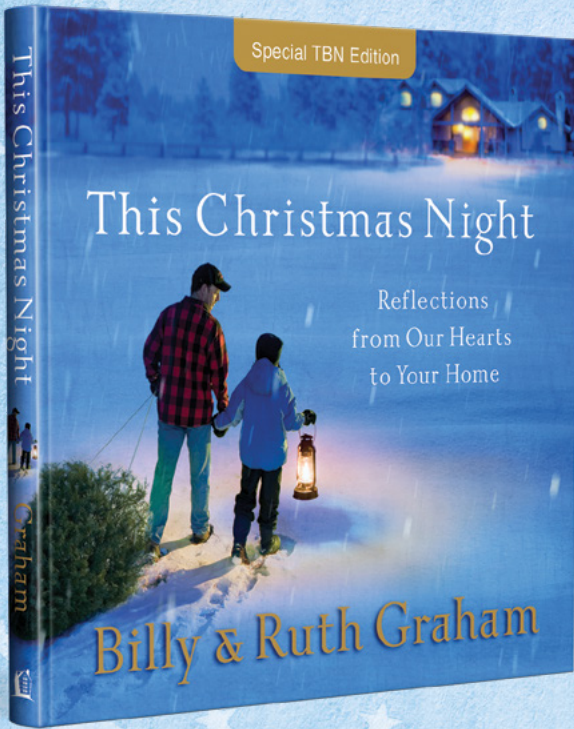
