- 1. A radio station is for sale in Los Angeles let's claim it for the ministry of TBN! This would reach out into a whole new dimension of Southern California into automobiles and other areas where TV is not available. Oh partners, please pray that God will give us this new voice with which to Praise Him!
- Already apportunities are ours to supply some of our TBN programs to foreign fields. Let's accept this challenge and release this ministry to the utter most parts of the world. We will need

more video tape and funds to pay for translation into the various languages.

3. We must build ourregular monthly gift income up to \$50,000 per month. This will supply the need to fully pay our staff of workers and meet our monthly obligations for the operations of Channel 40.

- 4. We believe God raised TBN up to be a true network with other stations and other affiliates who will carry the programs which are produced at TEN. God will bless us ONLY if we reach out to others to pass the blessing and the miracles on!

to produce better Christain TV. We have invested a total of approximately \$200,000 in our entire package of TV equipment. This may sound like a large sumhowever, when compared with other TV stations it is pitifully small. NBC spends more than this for one camera! Even other Christian TV stations have found it necessary to invest an average of \$500,000 for studio equipment alone. Please pray, this is an urgent need.


Marie Holstrom of Chatsworth wrote:

Dear Friend in Christ:


