Vicki feels that this is what the Lord has allowed her to experience to learn that she is not alone. God is with her always. She now knows she belongs to the Lord to be of service to Him. She says now her life is beautiful in the Lord. Her circumstances have not changed, but she has never been happier. (Philippians 4:11, "for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.")
