I praise God for the PTL Club. As I watch the show through-out the week it has helped me to become more interested in the things of God and giving Him the praise.

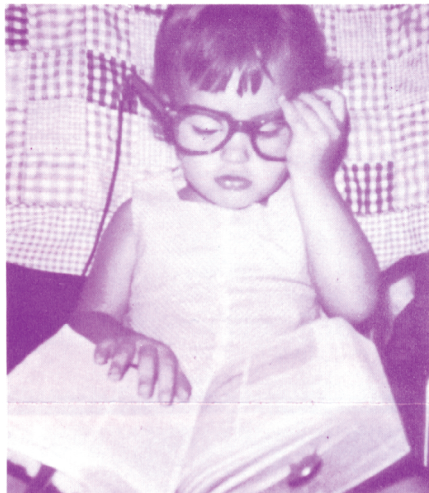
I felt the need to let you know how important Channel 40 programming is. God has continued to help me in so many ways. I have sent an offering which I hope will help. Praise the Lord!
