I know from my own experience as a dad that at their best every father falls far short of all he would like to be and do for his kids. And it's certainly no secret that more than a few among us struggle with memories of fathers who were abusive, unengaged, distant, or absent.

But regardless of what kind of earthly father we had, through Jesus each of us has access to a heavenly Father who loves us without measure, is ever-present in our lives, and is committed to our good. Nowhere is the life-changing truth of the Father heart of God more evident than in 1 John 3:1: "Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!"

Our vision at TBN is for every person to know the embrace of our heavenly Father's love. It is no secret, however, that right in our own nation we are faced with an ongoing father-hood crisis that has wreaked havoc on individuals, families, and society as a whole. The U.S. Census Bureau says that approximately 17.6 million children in America are living without a father in the home. To put it in perspective, that is twice the population of New York City or more than four times the size of Los Angeles.

Of course, those sobering numbers didn't happen overnight. They're a product of decades of cultural trends that have minimized the importance of strong families and fathers who are active in nurturing their children. And the results have been fractured lives and relationships, a steady increase in addictions, crime, and other dysfunctional behaviors—and children who grow into adults with an uncertainty of their value, place, and purpose.

But there is hope in this crisis! As believers, each of us has experienced the life-changing compassion of the heavenly Father, who loved the world so much that He gave His only Son so that "whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16, NKJV).

Scripture is clear that God's love is laser-focused on every individual who needs to be redeemed and restored to His forever family. In Luke Chapter 15, Jesus emphasizes this truth in two powerful parables — of the shepherd who leaves the ninety-nine sheep that are safe in order to seek and find the one lone sheep that is lost and alone (vv. 4-7); and of the woman who has lost a valuable coin, and "searches carefully until she finds it" (vv. 8-10). In each of these unforgettable stories, the conclusion is the same: there is great joy in heaven for each lost soul who is found and redeemed.

Finally, Jesus tells the parable of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32). We all know it well: even though this young man had rejected his home and all the advantages his father had so lovingly provided, had wasted his inheritance, and was lost and without hope — when he found his way back home, he discovered a loving father waiting to receive and restore him to his family.


