LOCAL PRAISE THE LORD




The first guest was Eileen Vincent. She, along with her husband, founded City Reachers for the Love of San Antonio. In addition to this she has been a worldwide minister in Europe, Asia, Africa, India, and the U.S. She is a published author of five books, and hosts a weekly radio broadcast "Pray San Antonio." Eileen speaks about the movement that God is doing in San Antonio where His people are unifying and cooperating across churches and cultures. She mentions that there is a cohesion taking place. She specifically speaks about the San Antonio Christian Leader's Forum as an example. This forum is a gathering of leaders who are in positions of influence throughout the city, to not only speak about transforming the city, but take actions towards doing so. Eileen testifies about the prayers that God has been answering citing the election of a godly woman into the mayoral office of San Antonio.

The second guest was Pastor Eliezer Bonilla. He is the pastor of Abundant Life Church of God. Pastor Bonilla spoke about the impact that latino community is having in today's society. He states that God has brought the christian evangelical latino to the forefront in this nation, not to curse it, but to bless. Pastor Bonilla notes that in the last twenty years the latino church has been infusing the lifeblood into the church in this nation. He references the earlier guest, Eileen Vincent, as a witness to the movement of God in unifying the different ethnic groups of the nation to better serve God. He warns that if the church does not act prophetically, another election is going to go by without the people of God being prophetic powers of influence in this nation.

The third guest was Pastor Brandon Clack. He is the pastor of Living Waters Community Church. He spoke about the word that he and his wife received from God for the church they pastor. This word dealt with crossing over from good things in one's life to great things. Pastor Clack spoke about the ministry that he and his wife have. His wife, Cristabel Clack, is a worship leader who has collaborated with renowned worship leaders around the world. He shares how God moves through her singing ministry through healing and restoration. Pastor Brandon spoke about the mission that his church is pursuing in reaching out to the lost and hurting people with bold love.

The fourth guest Alfred Gallegos. He is the Worship Pastor at Westover Hills Assembly of God. Alfred spoke about the experience of discovering how great God's love really is through the birth of his son. He shared that his ministry of music has always been a part of his life, and how God has taken him through a process to bring him to this point in his life. Alfred explained that he recently completed an album of songs that God first gave to him to share in churches. But as Alfred began sharing them, he felt God calling him to record them so that they could minister to a wider audience.
