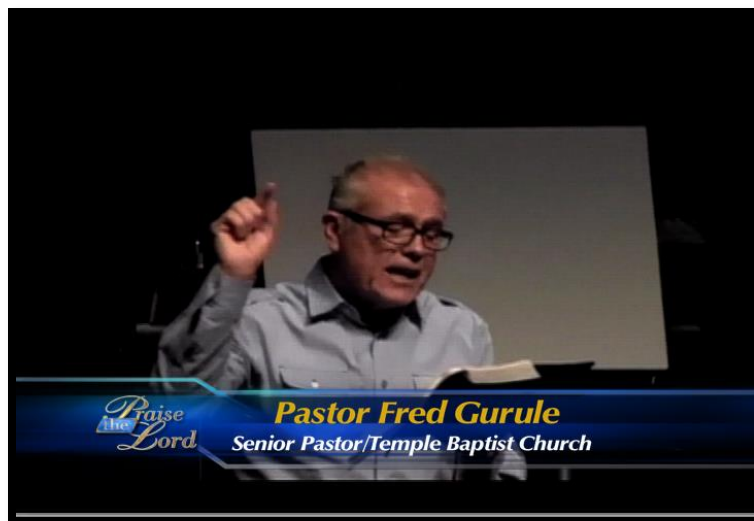

PRESS CONFERENCE – HB55 NM Religious Freedom Act

January 15, 2016: KNAT-TV attended a **press conference** regarding **HB 55, New Mexico Religious Freedom Act**, which would amend the current act to prohibit the application of a law that burdens the free exercise to religion and to prevent the discriminatory action by a person or government entity in response of a person's free exercise of religion. Representatives David M. Gallegos and Nora Espinoza spoke to the press and other leaders and indicated that this act would restore religious freedom and foster respect for religious beliefs of individuals without imposing those beliefs onto others. In addition, this act would prohibit legal retaliation towards business owners because of religious beliefs.



January 21, 2016: KNAT-TV attended the AMA (Albuquerque Ministry Alliance) meeting. AMA is a collaborative effort of Christian churches and ministries in our city. We set up a KNAT-TV booth with TBN newsletters, giveaways, prayer request forms, HLE brochures and materials to meet EEO requirements regarding how to obtain a career in broadcasting. Several contacts were made with area ministry leaders and pastors. Guest speaker was Mike Oppedahl with Giant International, addressing the topic of Ministry in Business (the marketplace).
