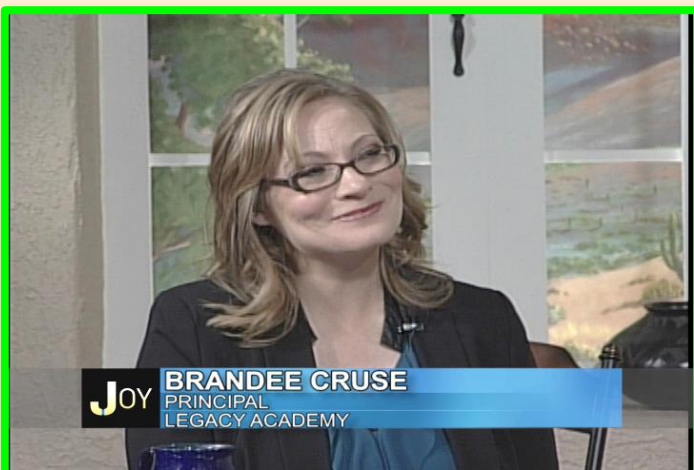

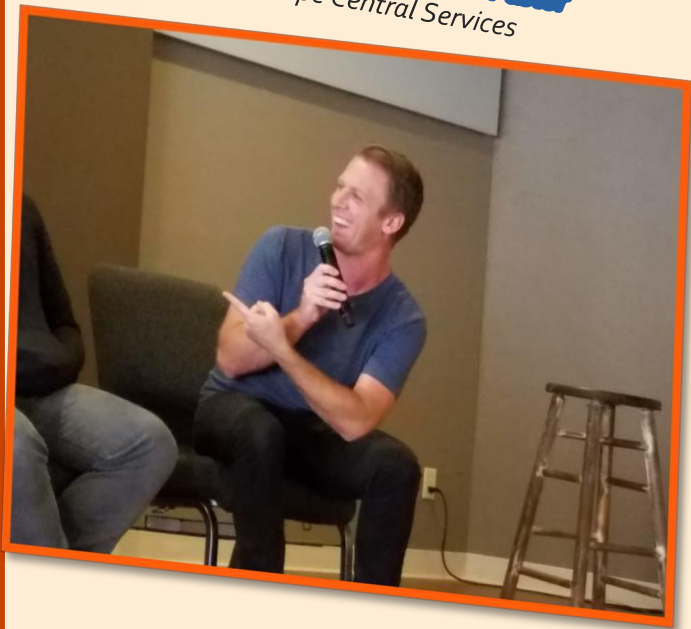
KNAT-TV23 was invited to attend the Albuquerque Ministry Alliance meeting at Hope Westside Church On Thursday, October 20th. The focus of the meeting was about the critical importance of church plants in Albuquerque. A panel of three lead pastors who have had experience in the mission of church plants throughout the U.S., South America, and Europe spoke about the importance of church planting in our local community. The discussion centered on how church plants are the best way to reach out and spread the gospel. Participants emphasized that church plants:

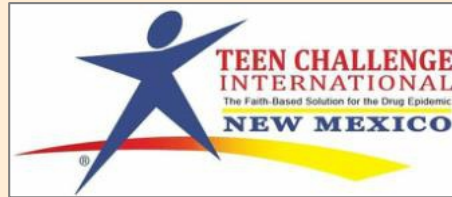
- Mobilize and raise leaders.
- Tend to be more open to outreach.
- Increase the numbers of believers more rapidly, primarily because of the gospel saturation that church plants provide.

In addition, they discussed the need for more churches in Albuquerque, especially in the SW and NW parts of the city because of crime in these areas. There was also discussion on uniting all believers to accomplish the Great Commission, (Matthew 28). Churches must decide NOT to live in competition of one another. Several pastors were introduced who are involved in local church plants. There was a call for prayer for the Great Commission in our community. The following question was asked: Is there evidence of Jesus' reign and rule in our city?

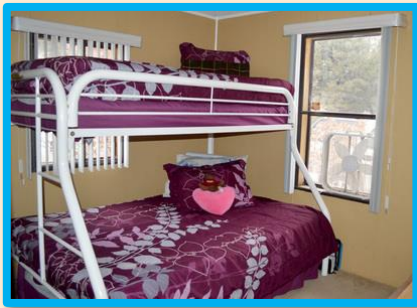


PILLOWZZZZZ
