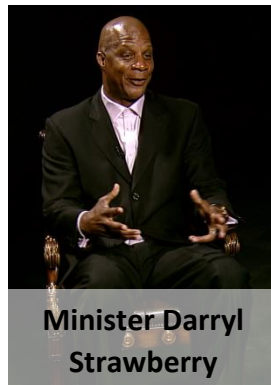
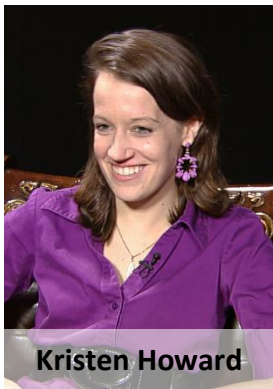
Joy In Our Town Production

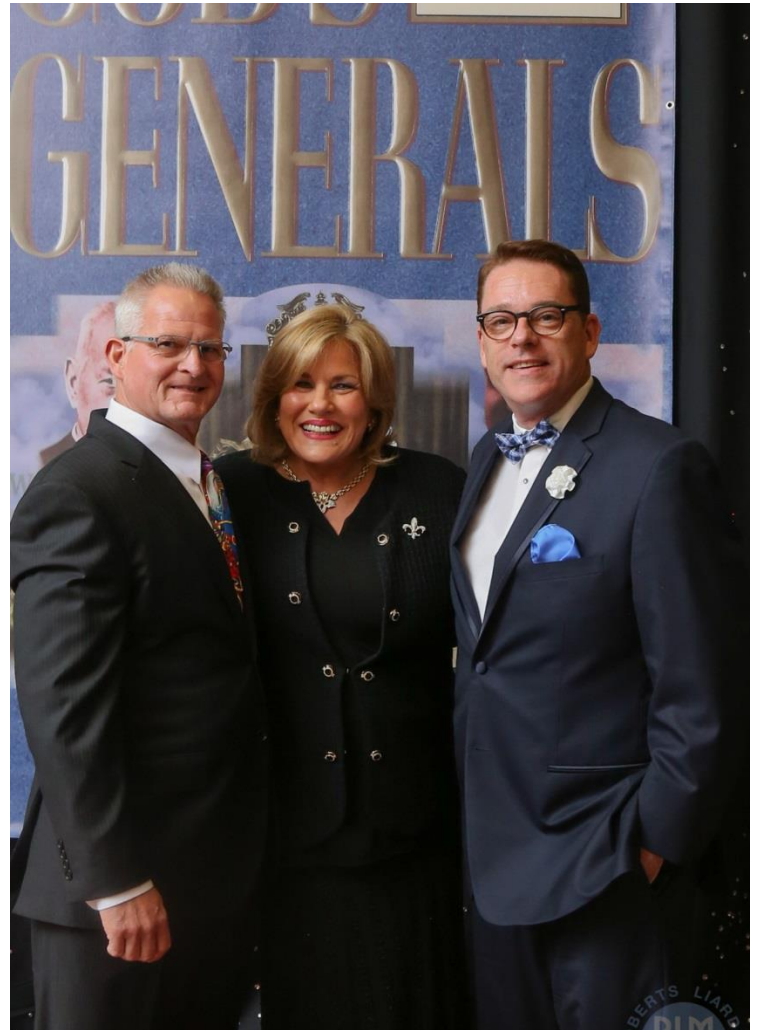
Happy Birthday Roberts Liardon!

His books have been translated into more than 60 languages, and over 15 million have been sold worldwide. As a teenager, at age 13 Roberts started preaching and was inspired to begin writing and producing a book and video series entitled **God's Generals**, which chronicles the lives of Protestant Christian leaders. The first volume on Pentecostal and Charismatic ministers was an immediate success, and with subsequent volumes Roberts has become a recognized authority on the history of

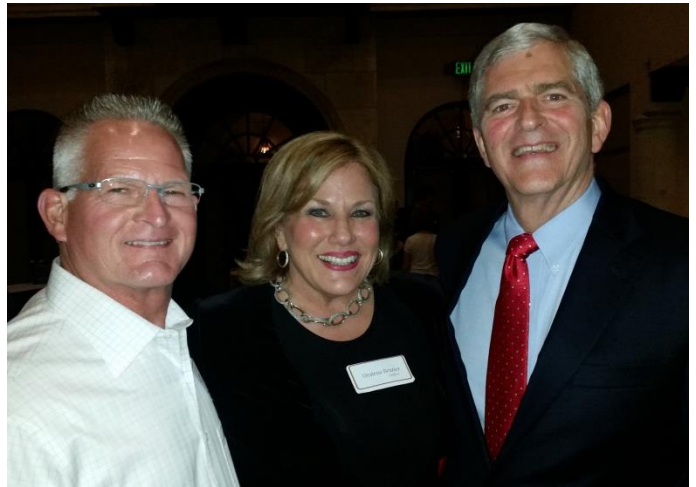
Cocoa Beach Chamber of Commerce Meeting
