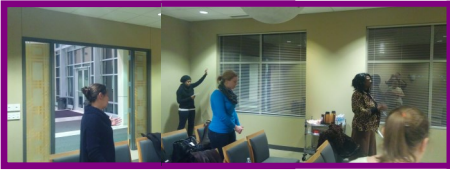

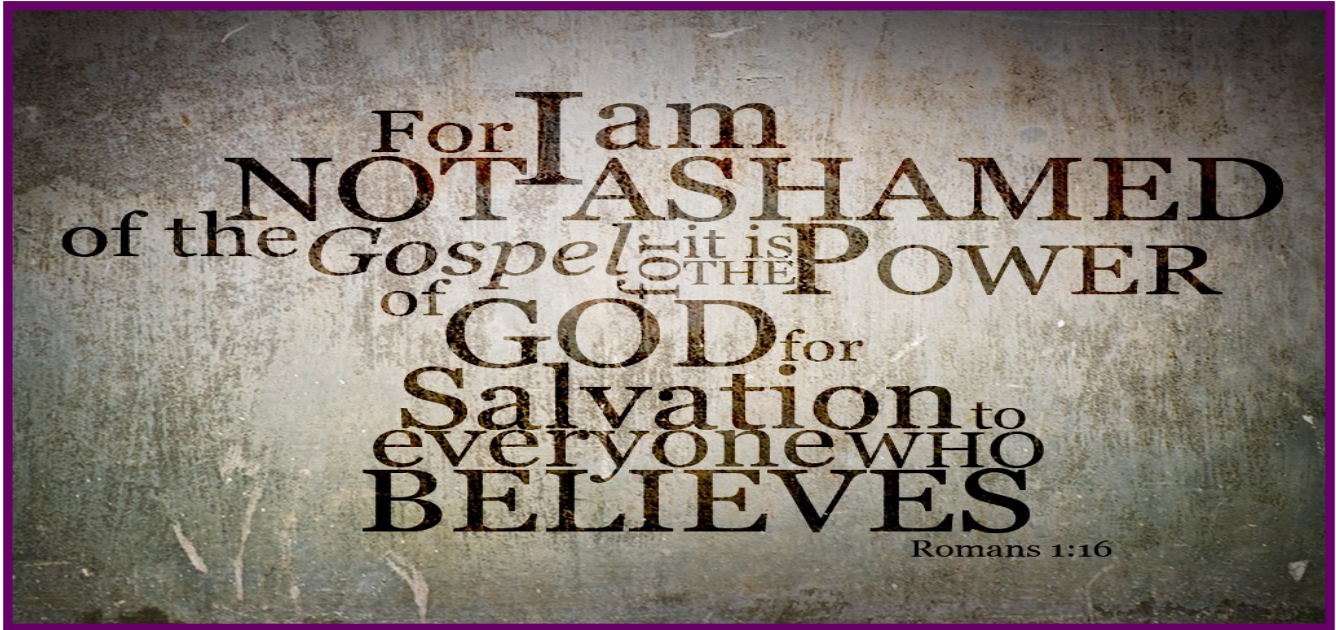
Community Outreach
